<p><b>Program Updates</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>School Program Workgroup Update</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Most recent Regional School OH Program workgroup was Dec. 5<sup>th</sup></li> <li>○ Progress – See slides for graphs</li> <li>○ Action Plan – First Draft of action plans for the top two priorities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Improve Referrals and Linkages – Improve, increase, and track for continuity of care beyond what is provided at the schools</li> <li>▪ Expand Education and Awareness – for students, parents, teachers, school administration</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Additional Updates</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Statewide 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Smile Survey – purpose is to collect updated information on the oral health status of 3<sup>rd</sup> graders. OOH is overseeing the survey data collection. We will need assistance in recruiting schools from their sample list to participate in completing the survey. UPDATE: This will be conducted during the 24/25 school year.</li> <li>○ Statewide dental referral management system – More info to come from the state in the next 2-3 months.
