TOOTH DECAY (CAVITIES) IS THE MOST COMMON CHRONIC DISEASE AMONG CHILDREN, BUT IT IS PREVENTABLE!

Almost 3 out of 4 third graders and more than half of kindergarten students in the county have had tooth decay.

- Students who miss school due to dental problems cost California school districts about \$30 million a year.
- A dental program at your school can lower absences and provide easy access to dental services for students and their families.

- **74%** of schools have a dental program
- **40%** of schools have onsite kindergarten screenings
- 32% of schools have onsite preventative services like cleanings
