The Vernon Dental Specialty Group team also attended a CFS event with Smile SBC in the city of San Bernardino. • KOHA and SCOHR Updates for the 2024-2025 school year KOHA we are at 60% of enrolled Kindergarteners screened which is meeting the State target for 2027! Thanks to the support and efforts of school dental partners and our participating school districts, we are ahead of target! 25 out 32 school districts have submitted KOHA data in SCOHR, which brings us to 78% of districts in the county. The remaining 7 schools currently do not have an oral health program, of which we are aware.
